Scholarship(s) are awarded based on funds available and support tuition at Class Act Dance and Performing Arts Studio in Paso Robles, CA for a one year term, from September 1 through August 31 of each year.

Students may apply for this scholarship by submitting the following:

- 2. Provide a Household financial statement, including a copy of the most recent tax return.
- 3. Provide Personal References:
 - a. 3 letters of reference regarding desire to learn: 1 from a dance teacher, 2 from academic or other
 - b. 2 letters of reference regarding character, from non-family members
